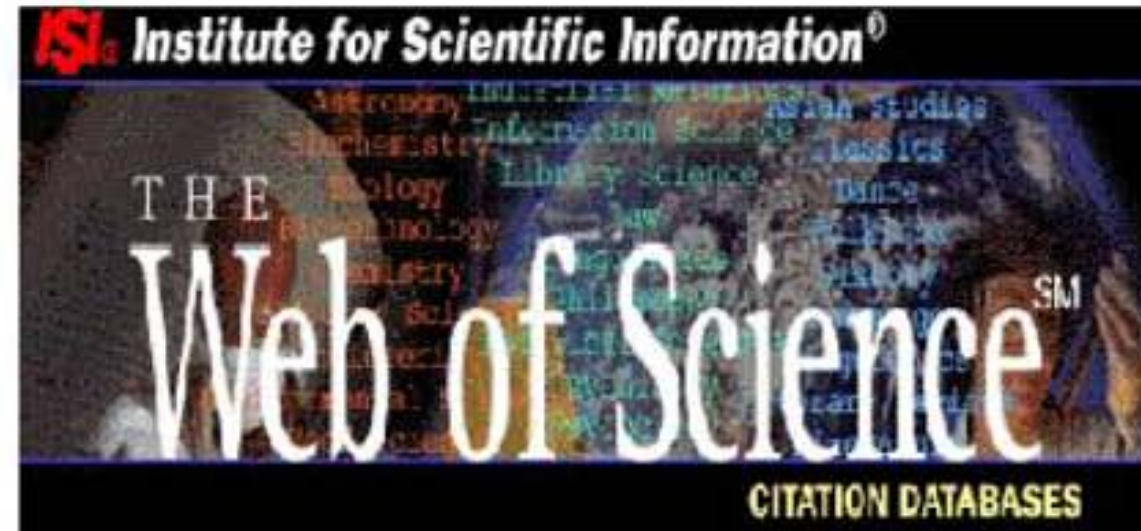

ISI: the Background

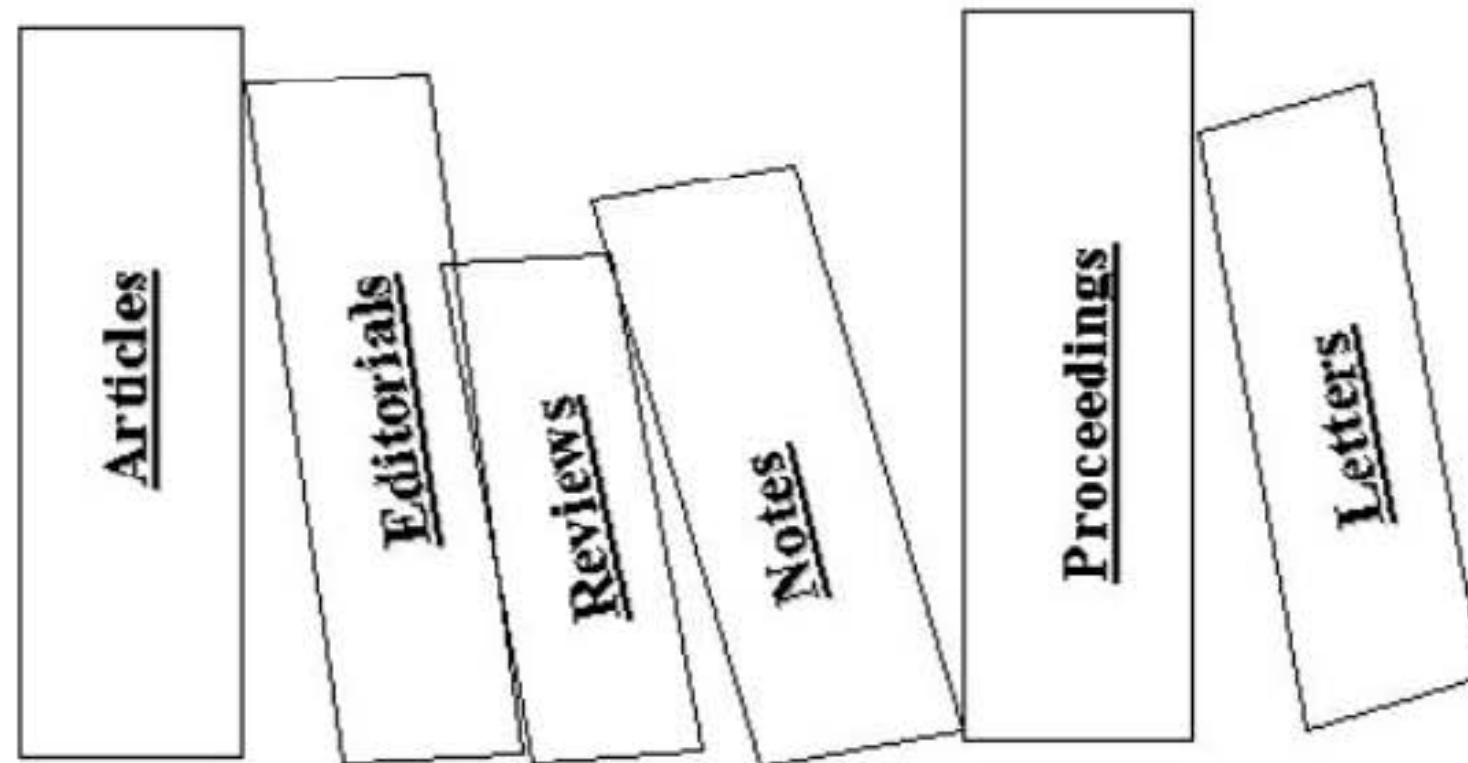
- Was founded by Eugene Garfield in 1958

- Providing research information to the scientific community

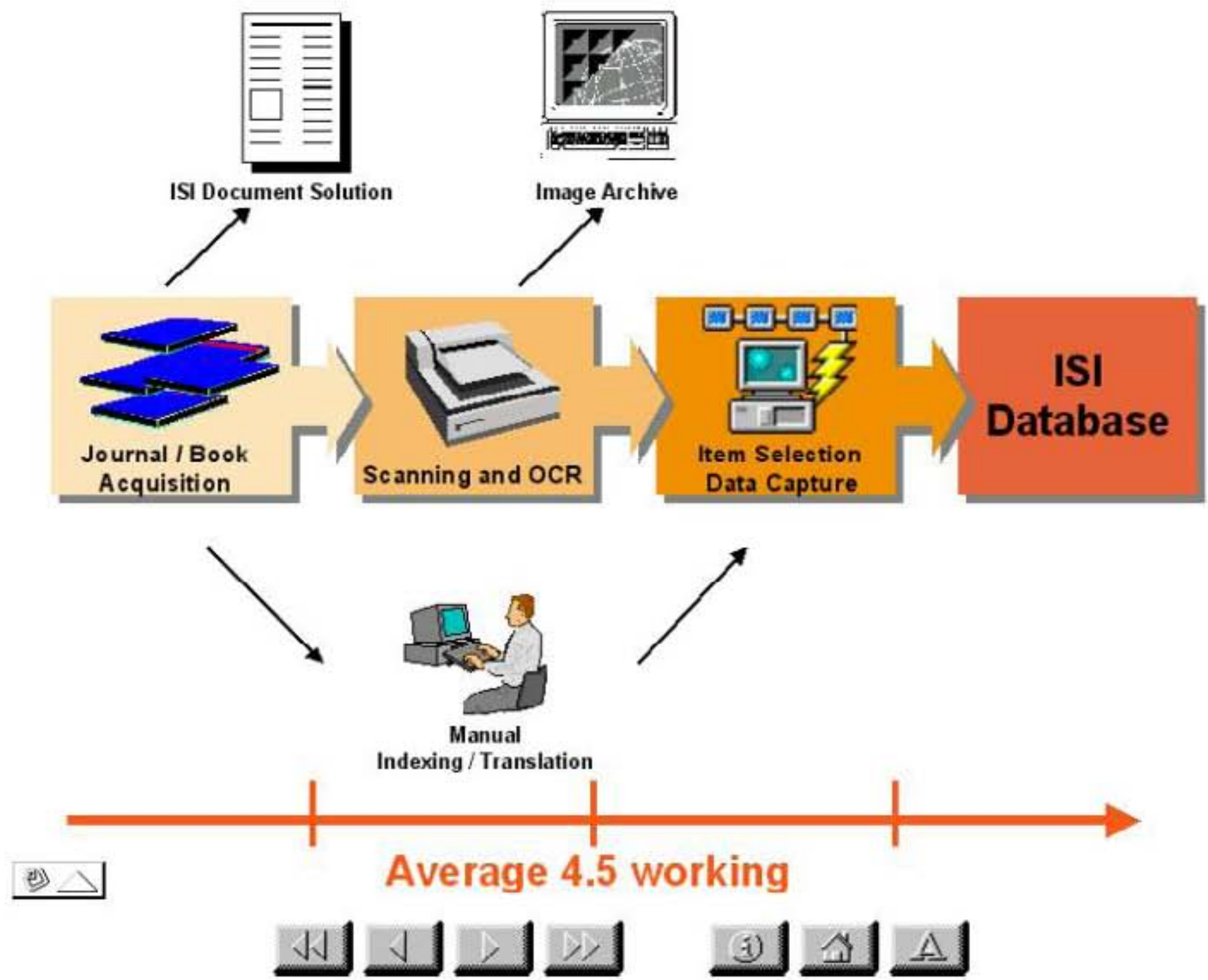


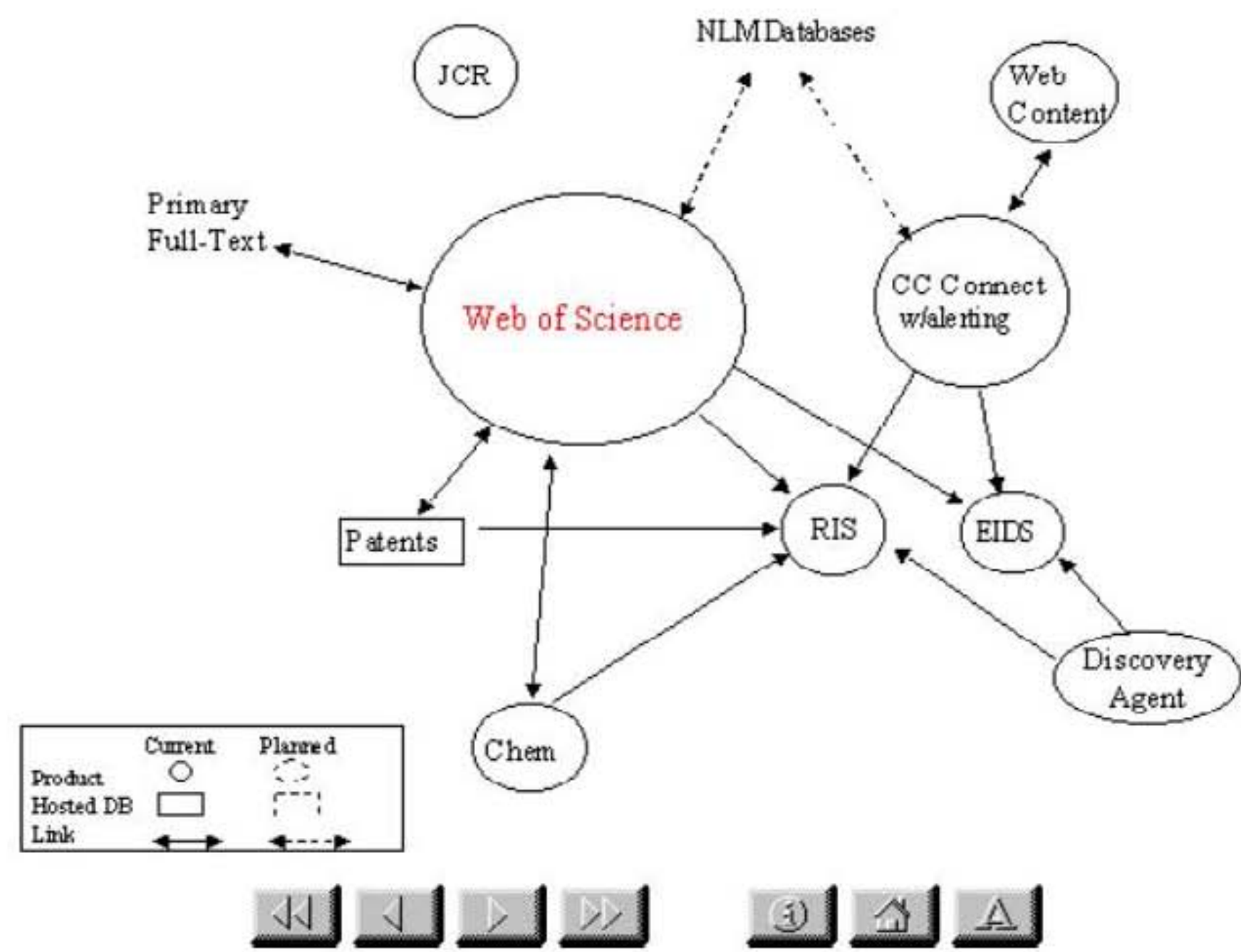

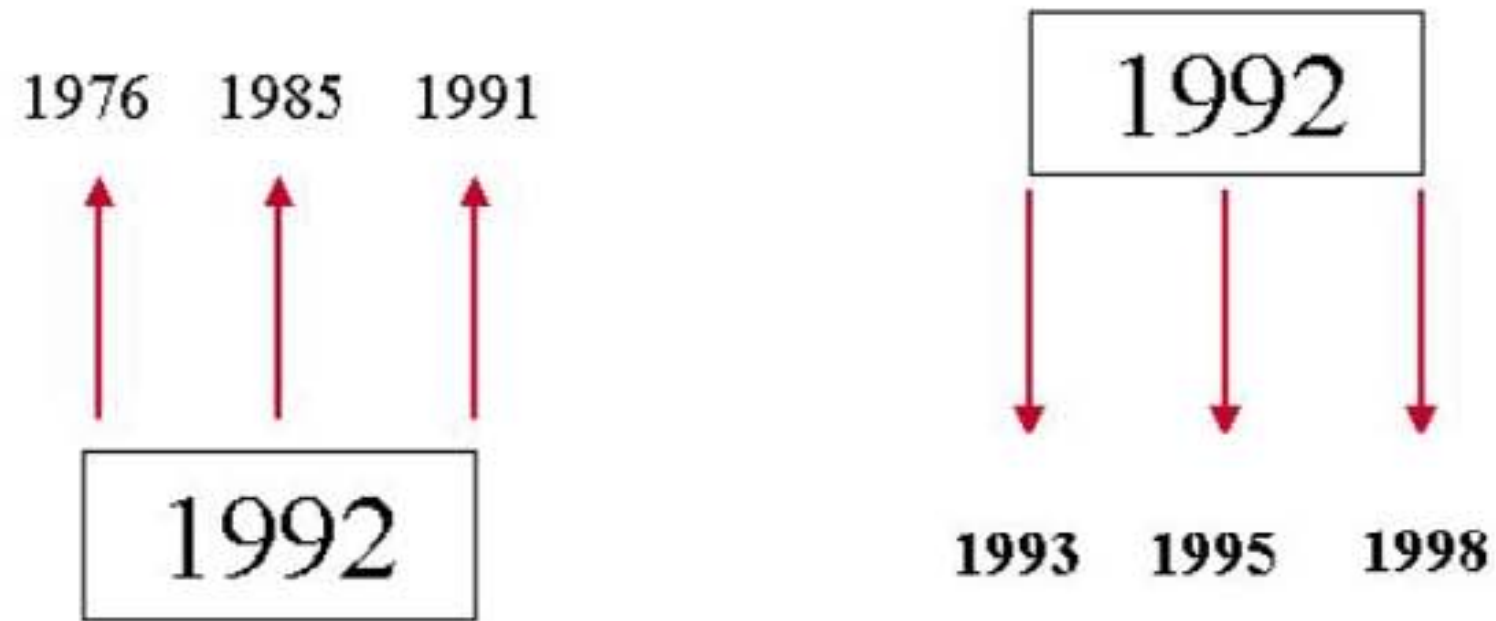
What Is a Citation Index ?

- An integrated collection of scientific literature containing....
 - Article titles
 - Author names and addresses
 - Article type
 - Journal titles, volume, pages etc.
 - Author keywords and keywords plus
 - Author abstracts (from 1991 onwards)
 - Publisher address & home-page
 - Cited references





Cited Reference Search



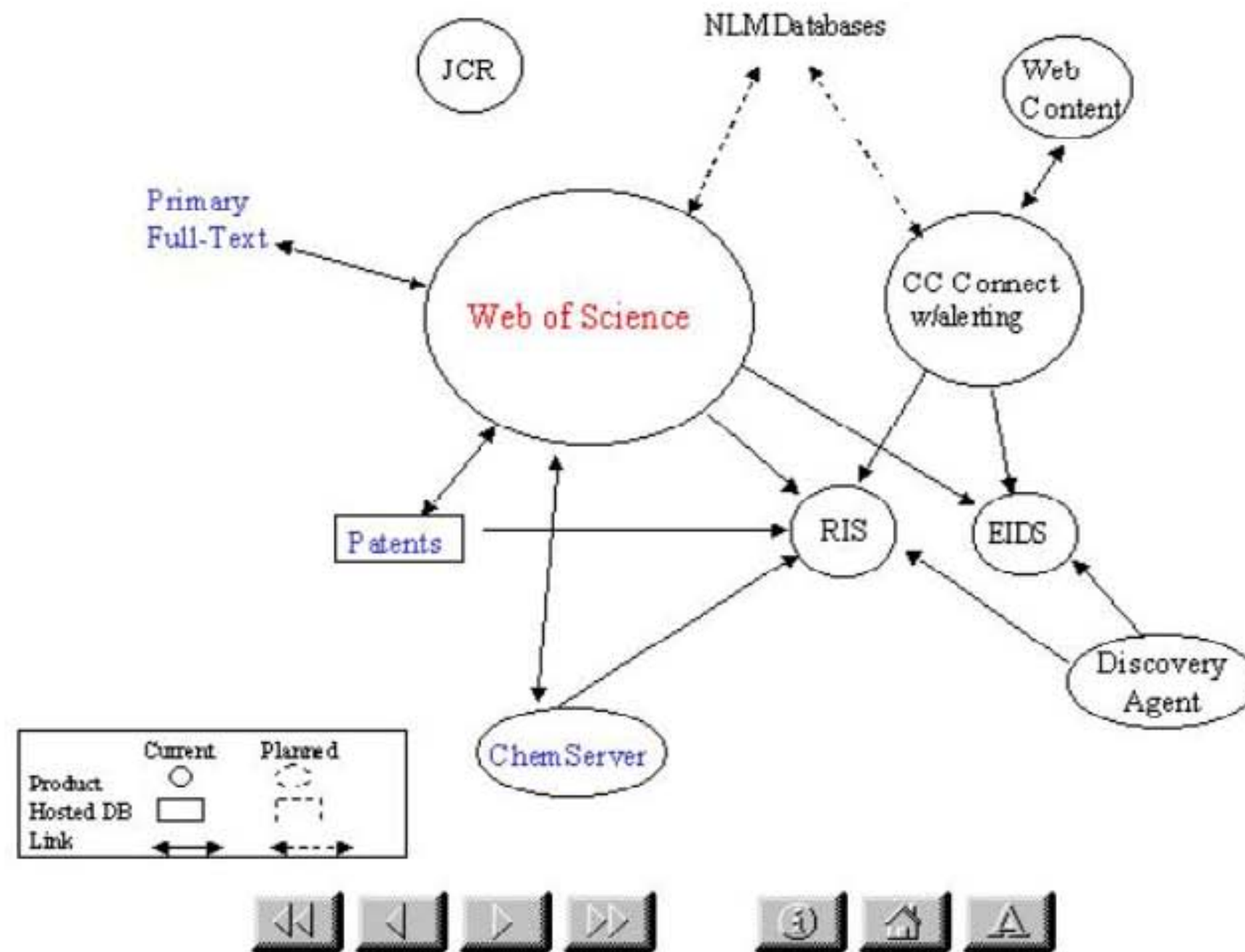
□ Features

- Social Sciences Citation Index

- ❑ Back-year processing continues for 1945 forward



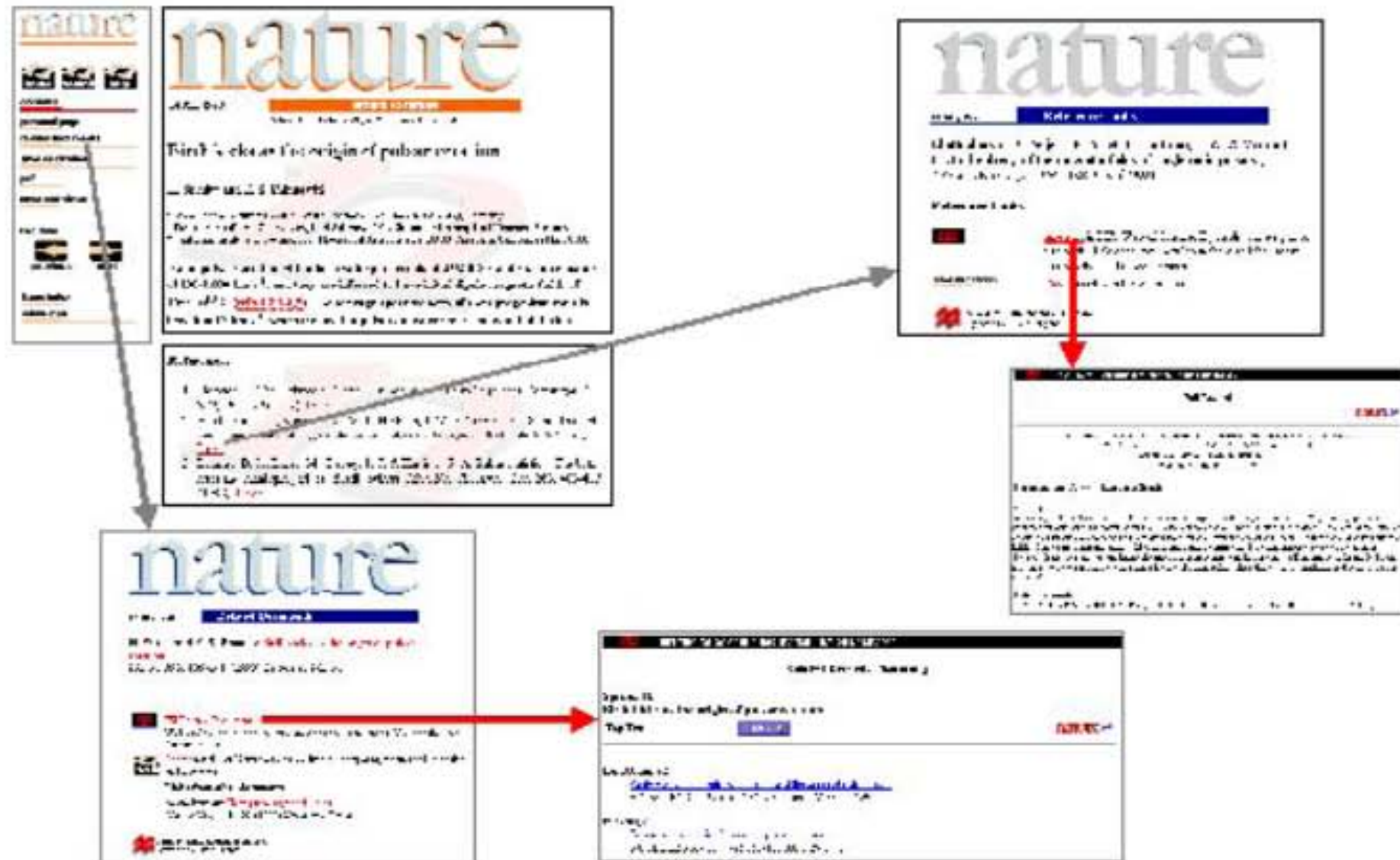


- **Goals:**
 - › Provide ISI customers with access to related content on the Web
 - › Allow WoS users to link to the full text available at publisher's and local sites
- **Two Models:**
 - › Subscriber
 - * Link Out: ISI's content ⇒ full length article
 - * Links In: cited ref in article ⇒ citations in WoS
 - › Non-Subscriber
 - * From cited references ⇒ limited bibliographic records in WoS
 - * From full article text ⇒ related records in WoS
- **Internet and Intranet**



- Publishers currently with links enabled
 - › American Institute of Physics
 - › Academic Press
 - › Nature.
 - › SIAM is the next publisher to launch in late January.
